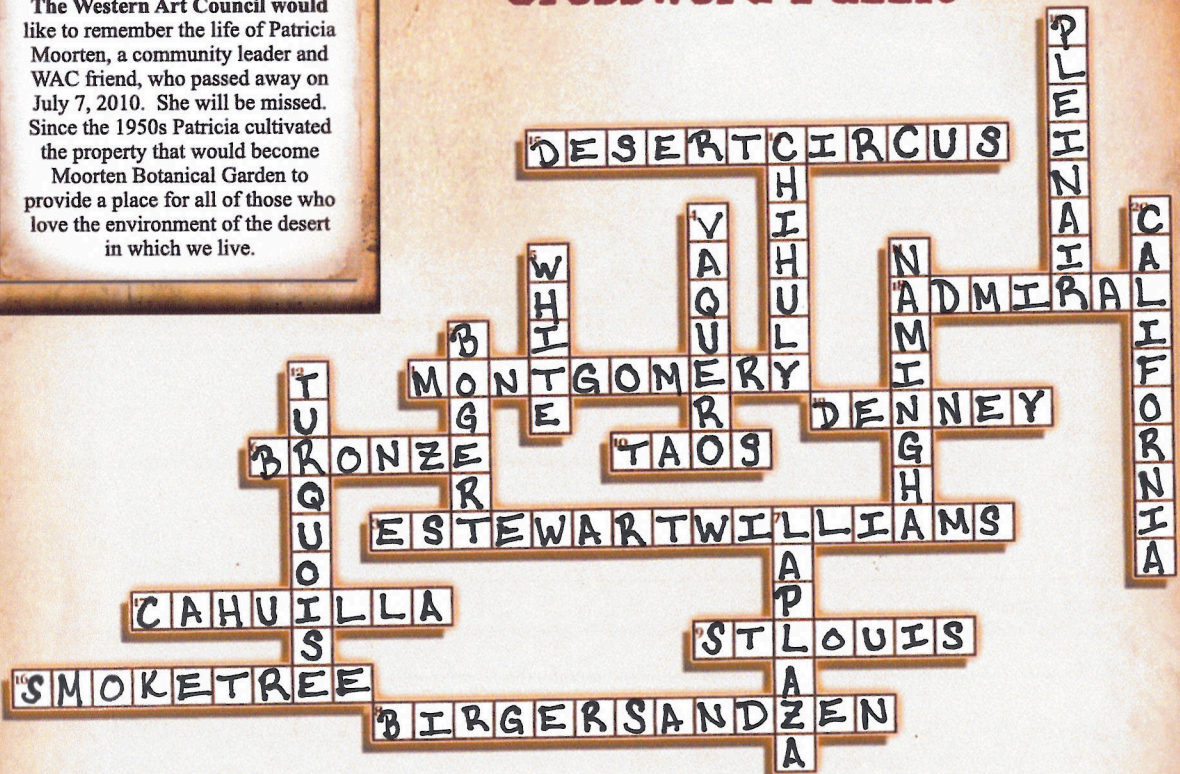


## Community Corner
