Palm Springs, CA (February 5, 2008) – The Annenberg Theater of the Palm Springs Art Museum will be the home of two-time Grammy winner Christine Andreas (*Oklahoma* and *On Your Toes*) on February 22, 2008 at 8:00 p.m. She will be performing *Love is Good...An Evening with Christine Andreas with Martin Silvestri at the Piano*. The evening's performance will be the actress and singer's favorite evening of song featuring the best of the American Songbook, as well as light contemporary, original and Broadway show tunes.



Ms. Andreas has performed her cabaret act in the Café Carlyle and the Algonquin Hotel's Oak Room in New York City and the Catalina Grill in Los Angeles, and has appeared in concert in London, Paris, Rome and at The White House and Carnegie Hall. She first took Broadway by storm as Eliza Doolittle in the 20th anniversary revival of *My Fair Lady*. She recently won the Barrymore Award in Philadelphia for best actress in a musical for *Pal Joey*.

Ms. Andreas' television appearances include *The Cosby Show*, *Another World*, and *Law & Order: Special Victims Unit*. She portrayed Ava Gardner in the made-for-TV movie *Love and Betrayal: The Mia Farrow Story*.
