GUEST CODE OF CONDUCT

Please do not touch any items on display. Touching can harm the art.

There are no backpacks permitted in the museum.

Bags larger than 11 Inches by 14 Inches are not permitted in the museum.

We ask that all guests remain four (4) feet away from all items on display.

For the safety and security of our guests, all bags or packages entering the museum are subject to search at any time.

There is no flash photography, or tripods permitted in the museum. Occasionally specific pieces or exhibits in the museum are not permitted to be photographed.

No food or drink of any type are permitted in the exhibit areas.

Open flames of any kind are prohibited.

Laser pointers, ink pens, markers, or umbrellas are not allowed within exhibit areas.

Children under twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied by a parent or other adult at all times. Children may not be carried on shoulders for their own safety and the protection of works of art. The use of back baby carriers inside of gallery spaces is prohibited.

Visitors and others are expected to follow the reasonable directions from authorized personnel; such as Security. This is especially important should an evacuation become necessary.

Please be mindful of the space and objects around you when taking selfies and keep a minimum of (4) feet away from the artworks to avoid contact and damage.

Selfie Sticks are not permitted in the museum.

No smoking or vaping inside of any museum building or structure.

Shoes must be worn at all times.
