

WHAT

A docent is a guide who takes people through the museum and helps them learn more about the artwork on display. As a Teen Docent you would give tours to elementary school children and guide them to interpret works of art and be more comfortable at the museum.

If accepted, you will attend museum training for three weeks in July and August to learn art history, public speaking, the interpretation of artworks, and how to create joyful learning at the museum. Training helps you prepare questions, learn how to think on your feet in front of an audience, and encourage multiple interpretations of a work of art. In September you will come once a week to practice and tour from October to December with an opportunity to extend into Spring.



TOURING

Tours take place on Tuesday or Thursday mornings from 9-11 a.m. You will get the chance to work with children and schools from throughout the Coachella Valley.

Available to students currently enrolled at a high school in the Coachella Valley. You must be mature, enjoy working with the public, have excellent people skills, and a willingness to work as a member of a team. Bilingual, Spanish speaking is encouraged.
