**Palm Springs Art Museum Celebrates  
Sold-Out Art Party 2026 Honoring Bob Mackie**

Palm Springs, CA (January 28, 2026) — Palm Springs Art Museum celebrated a sold-out evening at Art Party 2026, the museum's annual fundraising gala honoring legendary designer **Bob Mackie**. The evening brought together artists, philanthropists, and cultural leaders in celebration of Mackie's enduring influence on costume, design, and popular culture, with the award presented by his longtime collaborator and friend **Carol Burnett**.

Art Party 2026 exceeded expectations, successfully completing multiple matching gift challenges made possible through the generosity of Jane Emison, Jordan D. ### **Palm Springs Art Museum**

Palm Springs Art Museum is the largest cultural institution in the Coachella Valley. The flagship building, located in downtown Palm Springs, features compelling art exhibitions, a vast permanent collection, and the Annenberg Theater, all in a 150,000-square-foot, architecturally significant building. Five blocks away, the Palm Springs Art Museum Architecture and Design Center, Edwards Harris Pavilion, features exhibitions and programming that explores architecture and design. The museum's collection also contains two icons of modernist design: *Frey House II* (1962) on the mountainside behind the main building and *Aluminaire House™* (1932) on museum grounds.
